- Assist in the planning and implementation of geophysical surveys on the ground and in boreholes;
- Contribute to the planning of diamond drilling campaigns;
- Follow up and describe the drill core;
- Conduct targeted geological mapping and sampling;
- Regularly compile, process, integrate and interpret drilling data;
- Perform preliminary compilations and interpretations of drilling and field data;
- Make 3D geological modeling (including structures and mineralization);
- Ensure drill inspection at the health and safety and environmental levels;
- Assist his supervisor in all of the company's exploration activities;
- Perform any other task that the Chief Geologist may deem necessary to ensure the efficient conduct of the exploration activities.
