SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITIES

Reporting to the President, the Vice-president Geology and Exploration is responsible for leading the geology and exploration team. He is responsible for:

- Manage the identification of new properties and opportunities for joint ventures, define the targets exploration, overseeing the design and implementation of programs, the preparation and management of budgets;
- Be an active member of the Management team;
- The role also includes the design and implementation of health management systems, safety and the environment and the training of manpower;
- Identify and execute IRC exploration strategies, in consultation with the President and Director general, while reporting to the board of directors;
- Design, obtain approval and manage exploration programs at deposit sites and new ones projects;
- Supervise and implement a QA / QC protocol, an exploration data management system and relevant related information, including the compilation of geological databases, geochemical and geophysical;
- Prepare and manage financial reports, including budgeting and expenditure control, related to the design and execution of exploration programs;
- The incumbent works closely with the general manager and geology staff to obtain results that support the strategic goals of the company;
- Perform any other task that the President may deem necessary to ensure the efficient conduct.

- University degree (BAC) in geosciences (geology or geological engineering);

- Minimum of 15 years of experience in mining and precious metals exploration;
- Possess professional experience associated with the exploration of magmatic deposits of the nickel-copper and platinoid group is an asset;
- Ability to lead and manage a highly engaged geology and exploration team to obtain outstanding exploration results;
- Extensive experience with high, medium and low grade ore targets;
