SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITIES

Reporting to the Director of Geology and Exploration, the Mine Geologist is responsible for:

- Assisting his supervisor in all of the company's operations ;
- Supervise the work of the geologists and the technicians, responsible for the grade control, on the ROMPAD in the underground mine (Targeted mapping and sampling)
- Assisting in planning the work of delineation drilling;
- Implementation, follow-up and monitoring of diamond drilling and description (logging) of the drill core;
- Completing systematic geological mapping and targeted sampling ;
- Work in collaboration with the Technical Services department for short-term projects and mine development;
- Write the daily geological report with guidelines for development ;
- Supervising the processing, compilation, integration and interpretation of drilling data;
- Work on different mining exploitation sites;
- Perform other duties as the Director of Mine geology and Exploration deems necessary to ensure the effective conduct of mining activities.

REQUIREMENTS

- University degree in geosciences (geology or geological engineering);
- Applicants must be a member of *Ordre des Géologues du Québec* or *Ordre des Ingénieurs du Québec*;
- Good knowledge of the geological and structural phenomena of Archean bedrock ;
