- Ensures that the training programs run smoothly and are of high quality and also takes care of evaluation to meet legislative and corporate requirements;
- Collaborates with other departments writing internal policies and procedures related to this field of activities;
- Collaborates with other departments in setting up and / or maintaining various health and safety training projects;
- Produces required reports and statistics.
