- Ensures the application of the hygiene elements and measures contained in the establishment-specific health program and the elements and safety measures of the company's prevention;
- Ensures the implementation of hygiene elements in the prevention programs of the contractors working on the installations;
- Informs and trains workers about current programs and expected controls;
- Prepares the instruments and technical specifications for the assigned projects;
- Contributes to the improvement of workplace conditions and the control of recognized risks that may affect the health, integrity or well-being of workers;
- Implant and evaluate, as the case may be, protocols for standardizing occupational health interventions;
- Participates in or conducts the assessment of workplaces when his / her expertise is required;
- Maintains contact with Nunavik representatives and NRBHSS as needed;
- Proposes and implements initiatives to improve safety performance;
- Participate in accident investigations and follow-up recommendations as needed;
- Ensures the application of the regulations on health and safety at work;
- Conducts visits and inspections of operations sites.
