- Ensure enforcement of regulations by ensuring the conduct of drinking water production and distribution, sewage collection and treatment, and sludge treatment and disposal processes to ensure that control;
- Sampling, analyzing and characterizing raw water, waste water or treated from a physical, physico-chemical and microbiological point of view;
- Perform manual machining and plumbing work on the maintenance of drinking water and wastewater production and distribution equipment;
- Participate in process optimization;
- Performs other related duties.
